

Ride to Černá Hora peat bog, up the Černá Hora and around Černá hora back to Pe

The route starts from the hotel towards the slopes and then continues on the asphalt road up the hill around Žižkova Bouda, Husova Bouda up to Pražská Bouda. The ride will reward you with wonderful views and you can refresh yourself at



"Vebrovky" with sparkling wine. The route is asphalted and is little frequented.















Take the cable car to Růžová hora, via Děčínská bouda and Šraml to Pec

om the cable car stop Růžová hora 1:30 hours 5.5 km

Start by taking the cable car to Růžová hora, then continue via Děčínská bouda towards Velká Úpa and Portášky. Děčínská bouda is the highest located domestic dairy farm in the Czechia, where you can taste their dairy products. Afterwards, follow the asphalt road to the turnoff for the road called Sraml, which is an old original path to Pec.



Take a scooter from Herní krajina Pecka to Velká Úpa or Pec pod Sněžkou

Drive or walk from the hotel to Velká Úpa, take the cable car to Portášky, and explore Herní krajina. Then rent a scooter at SkiResort Live rental at the upper cable car station (we recommend buying a cable car ticket in package with scooter rental on skiresortcard.cz). Then either take the route to Velká Úpa, crossing the Portášky slope (5 km route), or the longer route (7 km) to Pec pod Sněžkou, where scooters are returned at the Relaxpark rental near the bobsled track.







Route via Lesní bouda, Chalupa Na Rozcestí, Výrovka, to Luční bouda and back to Pec
